

Concho County Budget Comments

In a separate link you will find the Concho County budget for 2013.

Pursuant to state law, the Concho County Judge serves as the budget officer for the county. Assisted by the County Clerk, the County Treasurer and with input from elected officials and department heads, the judge prepares a proposed budget each summer. Through a series of public meetings, the budget is then considered, amended if necessary, and adopted by the Concho County Commissioners Court.

In Concho County, funds are spent on a variety of efforts which are aimed at providing citizens with the necessary services and improving the quality of life in our communities. In addition to the maintenance of roads, the county provides funding for facilities, court systems, law enforcement, emergency management, fire protection, and more. These and many other activities are set forth in more detail in the budget.

For the past several years, Concho County has been focused on improving the County Roads. This project was only capable by the vote of the citizens in a bond election. As you drive thru the county you can see major improvement throughout the county on almost all roads that are affected by postal routes, bus routes, and high traffic areas.

On the bright side, even though we had additional expenses of paying back the bond in fiscal year 2013, you will note that the tax rate increase was only 0.010374 fiscal year 2012. Concho County operates on a balanced budget, and has for the past 3 years.
