Judge Dillard called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m., gave the invocation, and led the pledges.

**WELCOME AND PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Terry Smith gave Commissioners' Court updates on the Lake Ivie Volunteer Fire Department. He stated that they got the Generac generator installed and ready for anything that might happen. They just purchased a rainwater tank and will start to harvest their own water as soon as it is ready. He invited all the County Employees and anyone from Concho County to the Lake Ivie Fire Department's Spring Fling. It will be on Saturday May 2<sup>nd</sup> from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. They will be cooking burgers that will be free to everyone. He said that AirMed will be there as well as the Paint Rock Cheerleaders.

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS BURN BAN – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION (last action 4/14/26)**

No action taken. The Burn Ban will remain lifted.

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE JUDGE DILLARD APPLYING FOR UNCLAIMED PROPERTY CAPITAL CREDIT FOR COUNTIES, TO BE USED FOR CONCHO COUNTY LIBRARIES – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Commissioner Miller made a motion to approve Judge Dillard applying for Unclaimed Property Capital Credit for Counties, to be used for Concho County Libraries, duly seconded by Commissioner Gully. Motion carried unanimously. See Exhibit "B"

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE ALLOWING JUDGE DILLARD TO MAKE OFFERS ON THE 2 LOTS TO THE EAST OF THE OLD PRECINCT BARN – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Commissioner Dillard made a motion to allow Judge Dillard to make offers on the 2 lots East of the old Precinct 1 barn. Neither property is up for sale. David Currie owns the South lot, and Ruby Fikes owns the North lot. Judge Dillard will contact David Currie and see if he would be willing to sell the South lot, before any decisions are made. Commissioner Dillard retracted his motion. No action taken at this time.

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE DONATING TEXAS OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND MONEY TO A DRUG ADDICTION CENTER IN SAN ANGELO – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Judge Dillard recommended donating the money to the Alcohol and Drug Administration of the Concho Valley. Commissioner Miller made a motion to approve donating Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Money to the Alcohol and Drug Administration of the Concho Valley, duly seconded by Commissioner Gully. Motion carried unanimously.

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE REPORT FROM GABE STANSBERRY ON PREDATOR MANAGEMENT CONTROL PROGRAM – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Judge Dillard stated that he spoke with Mr. Stansberry, who was unaware of Commissioners Court being on Thursday. Mr. Stansberry requested to have him on the agenda for May 12<sup>th</sup>. No action taken.

**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE RAISING LIMIT ON COMMISSIONER'S CREDIT CARDS – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Mrs. Gierisch has already spoke to the credit card company and had the limit raised for the Commissioner's credit cards. No action taken.



**CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE ESTIMATE ON TRIMMING/REMOVING TRESS AT THE COURTHOUSE BY TREES EXPRESS – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Mrs. Hall explained the estimate that was submitted from Trees Express (Landscape Express). Commissioner Bradshaw made a motion to accept and approve the quote that was submitted, duly seconded by Commissioner Miller. Motion carried unanimously. See Exhibit "C"

The court took a recess at 10:22 a.m. to read through the previous meetings' minutes and Accounts Payable.

The court went back into session at 10:26 a.m. after recess.

**APPROVE MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS**

Commissioner Dillard made a motion to approve the minutes from April 14, 2026, Commissioners Court, as presented, duly seconded by Commissioner Gully. Motion carried unanimously.

**CONSIDER/APPROVE ALL ACCOUNTS PAYABLE FOR CONCHO COUNTY – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION**

Mrs. Gierisch presented the monthly Accounts Payable Claim Register from April 14, 2026, through April 30, 2026, with a total of \$141,708.06. She also presented the Payroll Summaries from March 15<sup>th</sup> - \$61,795.51; March 31 - \$59,313.24; April 15<sup>th</sup> - \$61,838.48; and April 30<sup>th</sup> - \$59,738.82, for the record. Commissioner Gully made a motion to approve and pay all accounts due and owed by Concho County, duly seconded by Commissioner Dillard. Motion carried unanimously. See Exhibits "D", "E", "F", "G", and "H", respectively.

**REPORTS, INFORMATION AND FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS – NO ACTION TO BE TAKEN**

Commissioner Bradshaw stated that the next time we do a Road Use Agreement, there needs to be something added that before any construction starts, the company needs to build the County Road up, at least 4 inches. With the rain and all the big loads going down the roads, he is getting calls every day from the public complaining about the roads. Judge Dillard stated that there is a new Road Agreement that is going to be presented on May 12<sup>th</sup>, and he will see if Aaron Clements can be present to answer any questions.

Commissioner Dillard stated that he has taken care of the letter that was sent to him by the Railroad Commission.

Commissioner Dillard stated that they had a good conference last week. He said that the Data Centers were the top discussion.

Sheriff Frazier stated that between his Deputy Abel Quezada and Trooper McMillan, there has been one trucking company that has pulled out of hauling material for the solar projects and LCRA. They have been citing drivers for equipment violations, no insurance, and people driving with no CDL, just to name a few.

Mrs. Hall gave an update on the Competency Hearing on the Capital Murder case. It has been continued to October 28, 2026, in Tom Green County.

The next Commissioners' Court will be on Monday, May 4, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. for a Special Meeting with Gallagher and Goldsmith Solutions. The next Regular Commissioner's Court Meeting will be Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.
